1. A letter or email from the applicant's academic adviser or other Harvard faculty member in support of this proposal (to be sent directly to CSWR by the faculty member);
2. A copy of the applicant's most recent Harvard grade report (a printout is acceptable);
3. A letter from the host organization documenting its approval/support of the applicant as an intern.
4. A curriculum vitae or resumé;
5. A one- to three-page statement of purpose written by the applicant, describing the proposed internship (the proposed plan of work [objectives, activities, location, dates, rough budget]; how it relates to interreligious understanding, peace, and justice; how your experience has prepared you for this internship; how this internship relates to your vocational/professional goals; and how this project will contribute to your learning as a part of your academic program at HDS).

If the proposed host organization is not known to the CSWR as demonstrated by the list on our website, please also provide:

6. A description of how the organization's work and the internship relate to the goals of the Dana McLean Greeley International Internship;
7. Background information about the host organization adequate for the evaluation of its appropriateness.

Application Instructions

Complete applications must be submitted between November 1 and March 6. Only applications submitted in their entirety by March 6 will be considered. The student is responsible for making sure that the application is complete, including the paragraph of support sent by the faculty member and the support letter sent by the prospective host organization.
